A NIGHT AT THE RACES - Join us for our Night at the Races event on Saturday, February 8th. Patrons will be treated to a catered dinner of Chicken Cordon-Bleu and Roast Beef. Following dinner (soft drinks and beer included) the excitement commences as the horse race portion of the evening begins. Each ticket entitles the bearer to name their horse.
