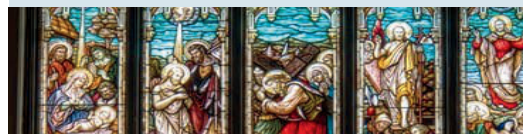

Historic Parish Bus Trip

Our parishes will be sponsoring a bus trip to visit historic churches in Cleveland Ohio on Sunday April 23rd. Departing from Central City (4:45 AM) with stops in Boswell (5:15 AM) and Latrobe (5:45 AM), the trip will include Latin High Mass at St. Stephen's (an historic German parish), as well as visits to St. Elizabeth (Hungarian), St. Casimir (Polish), and Our Lady of Lourdes (Bohemian/Czech). Following the church tours there will be a performance by the Tamburitzan Folk ensemble featuring ethnic dances from Ukraine, Croatia, Slovenia, Italy, Greece, and other old-world locales.
