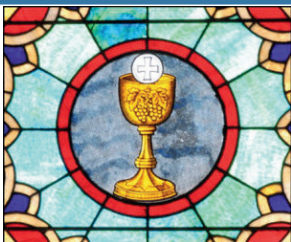

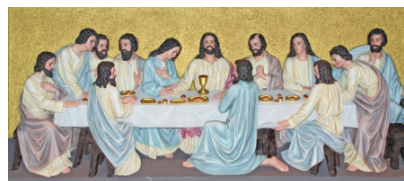
Corpus Christi

Boswell—June 11th

This Sunday, June 11th, All Saints Parish will celebrate solemn vespers at 4:00 PM in honor of Corpus Christi - the feast day where we pay particular attention to Christ's true presence in the Eucharist. Corpus Christi devotions typically feature an outdoor procession; this year Boswell's procession will include sawdust carpets, an old custom from Europe. The sawdust will be dyed and placed in feed sacks with multiple colors available. Anyone (as in you don't need to be a parishioner of All Saints) who is interested in exercising their creativity by fashioning a carpet is welcome to do so following Mass (11:45 AM) until 4:00 PM. The Eucharist will be exposed all day for quiet prayer and food will be available to all who make a carpet.
