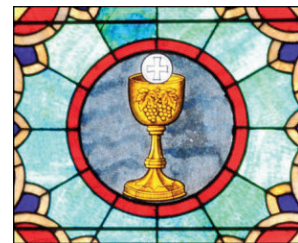
All Saints Announcements
