

All Souls Cemetery Candles

Since the very earliest days of the Church, people have visited cemeteries just as the three Marys went to the tomb of Christ on the first Easter Sunday. Down through the centuries the faithful have continued praying at the tombs of the saints, the martyrs, and all believers. Pilgrims to Jerusalem, who visit the tomb where Christ rose from the dead, will see lit oil lamps that call to



mind the "Three Marys" carrying oils to anoint Jesus' body. The Polish celebration of All Souls' Day (Zaduszki) as well as similar celebrations in Slovakia, Slovenia, Hungary, Croatia, and Italy, where lit candles are placed on graves, developed in part from this custom. Such customs help to provide a day for people to pray and honor the ones they miss with candles, flowers, and Masses, as well as meet neighbors who are also at cemeteries doing the same. In the Polish tradition the first days of November are often called, "Autumn's festival of Easter Resurrection". This custom was practiced in the new world by our forebears but over time faded as the dominant culture in America, which is Protestant and is opposed to praying for the dead, didn't help reinforce this powerful practice. As a way to rediscover our own Catholic belief and remember the closeness of this life to life eternal, All Saints Parish has purchased candles from Poland for use on All Souls Day. In Poland, and other countries where our families originated, cemeteries are so illuminated that it almost looks like day even at night (see pictures). These candles come in three sizes (the larger two sizes can be reused) and are priced at \$25, \$15, and \$10. The candles have a lid which allows them to burn outside. The church isn't really making any profit on the candles, they are pricey as they are imported from Poland. They will be blessed the weekend of October 28/29 and available after Mass that weekend or at All Saints Day Mass; the faithful who purchase candles can then take them to the graves of their loved ones. Because of limited quantities those interested must call All Saints office to order candles. After they are ordered, they can be picked up at Boswell, Central City, or Hooversville. Our parish cemeteries welcome this custom; if your loved ones are buried in other cemeteries please check their regulations to see if they permit lit candles. May our parish cemeteries, aflame with the light of resurrection, be a sign of contradiction in a world filled with so much darkness and death.
