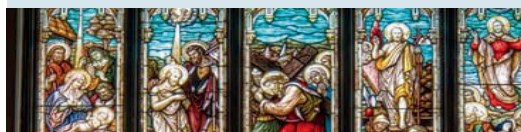

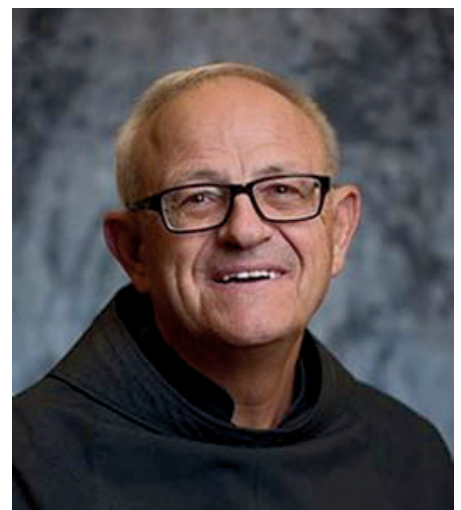
Fr. Romulus (Leonard Anthony) Rosolowski, OFM Conv., 77, a Franciscan Friar of Our Lady of the Angels Province, passed away peacefully on Saturday, October 28, 2023 at Mercy Hospital in Buffalo, NY. Born in Buffalo on September 15, 1946, he was the eldest son of the late Leo and Florence (nee Zielinski) Rosolowski. After graduating from Bishop Ryan High School in 1964, he entered the Novitiate of the Conventual Franciscans in Ellicott City, MD, professing first vows on August 15, 1965.

He completed his undergraduate studies at St. Hyacinth College Seminary in Granby, MA, during which time he professed solemn vows on August 15, 1968. After earning a Bachelor's degree in 1969, he traveled to Rome, where he studied at the Pontifical Faculty of Saint Bonaventure ("the Seraphicum") until 1973. He completed his M.Div. at St. Anthony-on-Hudson Seminary in Rensselaer, NY in 1974. He was ordained to the priesthood on May 11, 1974. His first assignment as a friar-priest was to the high school apostolate, teaching at Cardinal O'Hara between 1974-1976. He then served as Associate Pastor of Corpus Christi parish in Buffalo, until 1979, when he requested to work in the province's mission in Ghana. He served in West Africa from 1979-1983.

The remainder of Fr. Romulus' ministerial priesthood was spent in parochial settings: St. Francis of Assisi, Hamburg, NY (1983-86); St. Casimir, Baltimore MD (1986-91); Pastor of St. Paul Church, Atlas, PA (1991-94); Administrator of St. Stanislaus Kostka, St. Michael, St. Mary parishes, Shamokin, PA (1994-95); Co-Pastor of St. Paul, Kensington, CT (1995-96); Pastor of Holy Family, Hooverville, PA (1996-2003); St. Casimir & Emerich, and St. Columba, Johnstown, PA (2003-2005); a second stint at St. Francis in Hamburg (2005-2008); Our Lady of Victory Basilica, Lackawanna, NY (2008-2023).

Fr. Romulus is survived by his siblings, Robert (Kristin) Rosolowski, Sister M. Rosalind Rosolowski, CSSF, Dennis Rosolowski, David (Patricia) Rosolowski and like a brother to Mark Yourdon; also survived by loving nieces and nephews Thomas (Jessica), Natalie, Wade (Kathryn), Chelsey (Justin), Hannah (Erik); great nephew Parker; cousins, parishioners, many friends and the Conventual Franciscan Friars.

Visitation hours were held Thursday, November 2, from 3pm-7pm, at Our Lady of Victory Basilica (767 Ridge Road, Lackawanna, NY 14218), with a Franciscan Wake Service at 7pm. A Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated Friday, November 3, at 10am in the Basilica, followed by burial in Saint Stanislaus Cemetery, Buffalo, NY. Arrangements by JOHN J. Fr. Justin (Leonard) Anthony Ratajczak, OFM Conv. was born in Baltimore, MD, on February 2, 1949, and died on October 25, 2023 in Columbia, MD. He was the son of the late Leonard and Agnes (nee Guraleczka) Ratajczak. In addition to his Franciscan family, he leaves his brother Timothy Ratajczak. He is predeceased by his sisters, Denise and Jeanine.

Having grown up around the Franciscans as a parishioner and elementary school student at St. Casimir Parish in Baltimore, and having worked for a time in the family grocery store, Friar Justin entered the Novitiate of the Conventual Franciscans in Ellicott City, professing first vows on August 15, 1968. He then studied at St. Hyacinth College in Granby, MA (earning his B.A. in Philosophy in 1972), during which time he professed Solemn Vows on August 15, 1971. He then completed his M.Div. at St. Anthony-on-Hudson Seminary in Rensselaer, NY in 1977. He was ordained to the priesthood on May 7, 1977.

Fr. Justin's first assignments were in the high school apostolate. From 1977 to 1982, he taught at Cardinal O'Hara High School in Tonawanda, NY. He then taught at St. Francis High School in Hamburg, NY, until 1987.

He then transitioned to the parochial ministry, serving at St. Anthony of Padua, Fairfield, CT (1987-88); St. Stanislaus, Sharon, PA (1988-97); and St. Clement Mary Hofbauer, Baltimore MD (1997-2002). He was beloved at All Saints Parish in Boswell, PA, where he served as Pastor from 2002-2010. Fr. Justin's last Parochial assignment was as Pastor of the Church of the Annunciation in Baltimore, from 2010 to 2016. Due to illness, he was transferred to St. Joseph Cupertino Friary in Ellicott City, MD, before being moved into skilled nursing care at Lorien Health Services in Columbia, MD.

Viewing took place on Monday, October 30, from 5pm-7pm at the Church of the Annunciation (5212 McCormick Avenue, Baltimore, MD 21206), with a Franciscan Wake Service at 7pm. A Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated on Tuesday, October 31 @ 11am, also at the Church of the Annunciation. Internment followed @ 1:30pm, at St. Stanislaus Cemetery, Baltimore. 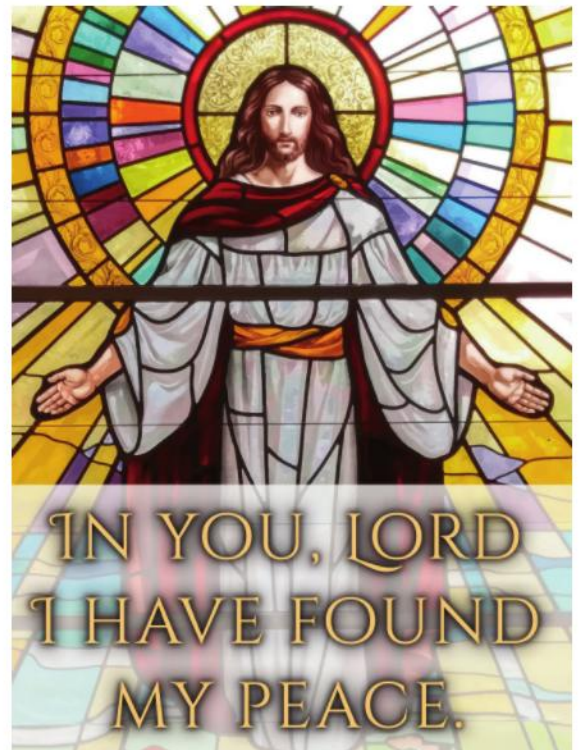

Acosta Church Items Available

From Father Aron

It is with so much sadness that our church in Acosta was closed and recently raised. As your priest I cannot fully grasp the pain this caused many of you. With that in mind the parish is offering the stained-glass windows and pews from Acosta to anyone who is interested. The parish council at All Saints made the decision to offer the windows and pews through an online auction. Let the record state, this is not to raise money. The council spent a lot of time trying to determine how to distribute the pews and windows fairly. If a family donated the windows, which family member should be offered the window since the original donors have all died? Moreover, if multiple families want the same pew, how can that be decided fairly? None of these items hold much monetary value, but some of them hold high sentimental value. An auction seems to be the only fair and objective way to distribute the remaining patrimony from the Acosta church. Please let anyone who might be interested in these items know that they are now available. It should be noted the pews and windows were removed by volunteers from our parish. In the process of removal some windows were damaged - they were very difficult to remove.
