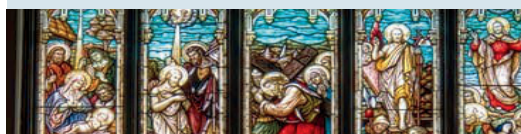

Saturday, December 16th—St. John Site

Our Lady Queen of Angels will celebrate a Rorate Mass at **6:30 AM** on Saturday, December 16th at the St. John site. The Rorate Mass is a very old devotion where the Mass of the Blessed Virgin Mary is celebrated just before dawn. The Rorate Mass is lit only by candlelight. As the Mass proceeds, the sunrise approaches in the church becomes progressively brighter – lit by the sun as our faith is illuminated by Christ. The interaction of light and darkness speaks to the meaning of Advent and the coming of the Light of the World. The Mass will be offered in English and Latin with Gregorian Chant conducted by longtime friend of the parish Professor Nicholas Will.

With that in mind the parish is offering the stained-glass windows and pews from Acosta to anyone who is interested. The parish council at All Saints made the decision to offer the windows and pews through an online auction. Let the record state, this is not to raise money. The council spent a lot of time trying to determine how to distribute the pews and windows fairly. If a family donated the windows, which family member should be offered the window since the original donors have all died? Moreover, if multiple families want the same pew, how can that be decided fairly? None of these items hold much monetary value, but some of them hold high sentimental value. An auction seems to be the only fair and objective way to distribute the remaining patrimony from the Acosta church. Please let anyone who might be interested in these items know that they are now available. It should be noted the pews and windows were removed by volunteers from our parish. In the process of removal some windows were damaged - they were very difficult to remove.
