PIEROGI – Presently the parish is selling frozen pierogi by the dozen. All pierogi are handmade by parishioners and come in three varieties, potato/cheese, sauerkraut, and prune. DYNGUS DAY – On Saturday April 22nd our parish will be sponsoring a celebration of Dyngus Day. Rooted in ancient Slavic custom, Dyngus Day is a day of merriment and celebration. While typically celebrated on Easter Monday the event has been moved to the following Saturday for *easier accessibility*. From 6:00 PM until 10:00 PM the celebration will include Polka dancing with music provided by Li'l John Nalevanko and the ATM Band, and an ethnic buffet including halupki (golumpki), pirohi (perogi), haluski, and kolbasi & sauerkraut. The admission price of \$20.00 per person also includes beer and other refreshments. Tickets are on sale at the rectory – all proceeds benefit trips and other outings for our CCD program.

GORZKIE ZALE SPEAKER THIS WEEKEND - FR. JOHN PAUL KUZMA - Father John Paul Kuzma, O.F.M., Cap. is a Capuchin Franciscan Friar who currently serves as the Parochial Vicar of Our Lady of the Mountains Parish in Cumberland, Maryland. A native of Erie, Fr. John Paul began his studies for the priesthood at St. Mark Seminary in Erie for the Diocese of Erie upon his graduation from Erie Cathedral Prep, an all-male Catholic high school. After earning his undergraduate degree in Philosophy from Gannon University, Fr. John Paul continued his studies at St. Vincent Seminary in Latrobe, all told spending six years preparing for the diocesan priesthood. Upon discernment Fr. John Paul felt called to the Capuchin Franciscans and completed his graduate theological studies at the Catholic University of America. He professed final vows as a Capuchin Friar in 2014 and was ordained a priest by Sean Cardinal O'Malley O.F.M., Cap., Archbishop of Boston, in 2015.
