DYNGUS DAY – On Saturday April 22nd our parish will be sponsoring a celebration of Dyngus Day. Rooted in ancient Slavic custom, Dyngus Day is a day of merriment and celebration. While typically celebrated on Easter Monday the event has been moved to the following Saturday for *easier accessibility*. From 6:00 PM until 10:00 PM the celebration will include Polka dancing with music provided by Li'l John

Nalevanko and the ATM Band, and an ethnic buffet including halupki (golumpki), pirohi (perogi), haluski, and kolbasi & sauerkraut. The admission price of \$20.00 per person also includes beer and other refreshments. Tickets are on sale at the rectory - all proceeds benefit trips and other outings for our CCD program.
