**Tuesday is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary.** While not a holy day of obligation, it would be commendable to come to Mass that day to pray for our Nation, under the patronage of Mary Immaculate. Please see the Mass schedule for Mass times.

*Did you know?* On December 8, 1854 when Pope Pius IX read the declaration defining the dogma of The Immaculate Conception, our own St. John Neumann held the book from which the pope read.

Today is St. Nicholas Day, observed as a day for gift giving in many places of the world. Both the Eastern and Western Churches honor St. Nicholas, and it is claimed that after the Blessed Virgin, he is the saint most pictured by Christian artists. And yet historically, we can pinpoint only the fact that Nicholas was the fourth-century bishop of Myra, a city in Lycia, a province of Asia Minor.

As with many of the saints, however, we are able to capture the relationship which Nicholas had with God through the admiration which Christians have had for him—an admiration expressed in the colorful stories which have been told and retold through the centuries.

Perhaps the best-known story about Nicholas concerns his charity toward a poor man who was unable to provide dowries for his three daughters of marriageable age. Rather than see them forced into prostitution, Nicholas secretly tossed a bag of gold through the poor man's window on three separate occasions, thus enabling the daughters to be married. Over the centuries, this particular legend evolved into the custom of gift-giving on the saint's feast. In the English-speaking countries, Saint Nicholas became, by a twist of the tongue, Santa Claus–further expanding the example of generosity portrayed by this holy bishop. *(Franciscan Saint of the Day)*
