September 28th & 29th

As part of the Diocesan Missionary Cooperation Plan, Reverend Kenneth Oguzie, CSSp, will visit Our Lady Queen of Angels, Holy Family and All Saints Churches this weekend to speak about the missionary work of the Church and in particular that of the Spiritans (officially Congregation of the Holy Spirit). This visit is part of a national program in which annually a representative of one of the missionary groups visits parishes of the Diocese to invite parishioners to share in the mission work of the universal Church. The Spiritans are an international community engaged in a wide range of missionary activity in over 60 countries throughout the world. Fr. Kenneth himself is a missionary priest from Zimbabwe. He is completing post-graduate studies in theology at Duquesne University in Pittsburgh, founded by the Spiritans in 1878.
