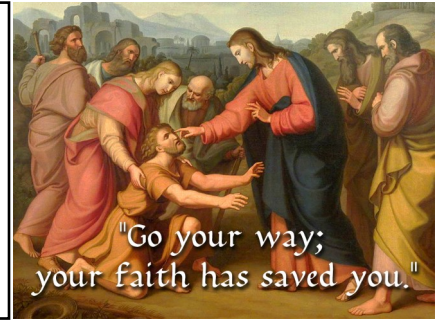
OLQA Sanctuary Candle Intentions
