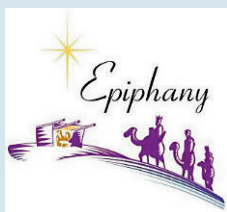

Slovak Class & Special Mass

Monday, January 14th

As a way to celebrate Slovak heritage and culture. A special Mass will be celebrated on Monday, February 14 at 6 PM at Queen of Angels Parish (Saint John site) in honor of Saints Cyril and Methodius, patron saints of the Slavs. Following Mass (in English with some Slovak hymns), Dr. Michal Kopanic will offer an hour long class on the origins of the Slovak people, Saints Cyril and Methodius, and a brief overview of various religions in Slovakia. In addition to a Ph.D. from the University of Pittsburgh and an M.A. from the University of Notre Dame, Dr. Kopanic studied at Comenius University in Bratislava and currently teaches at the University of Maryland.
