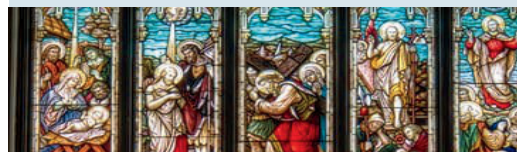

Today is Divine Mercy Sunday

•During his revelations to St. Faustina Kowalska in in the 1930's in Poland, our Lord requested that a feast day be dedicated to Divine Mercy and celebrated annually on the first Sunday after Easter. Furthermore, he instructed her to have an image created of his Divine Mercy that would be venerated especially on that day.

Here's what he told her:

Whoever approaches the Fountain of Life [Holy Communion] on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. (Diary, No. 300)

I want the image solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, and I want it to be venerated publicly so that every soul may know about it. (Diary, No. 341)

This Feast emerged from the very depths of My mercy, and it is confirmed in the vast depths of my tender mercies. (Diary, No. 420)

The Feast of Divine Mercy is celebrated in Catholic churches throughout the world on the first Sunday after Easter, known as Divine Mercy Sunday. On that day, the amazing image of Divine Mercy is venerated in most, if not all, of the churches.
