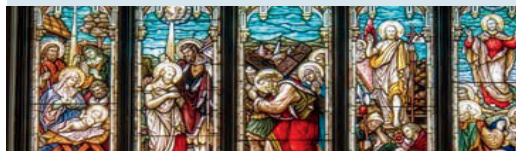

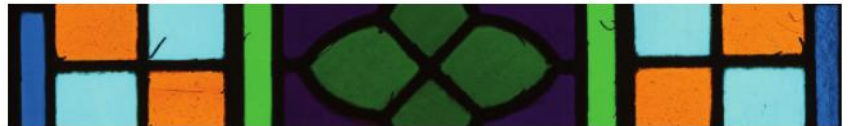

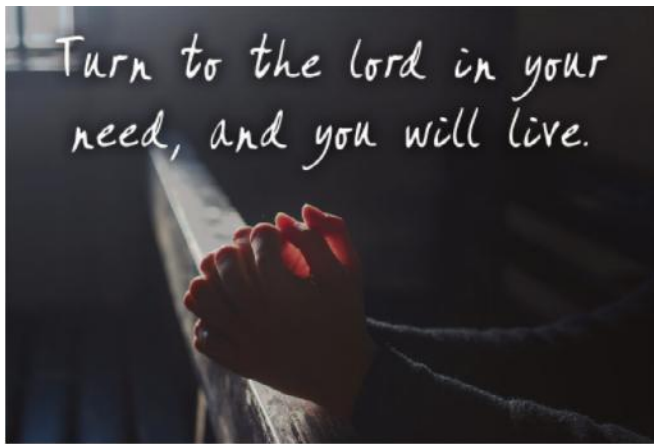

## Local Day Camp

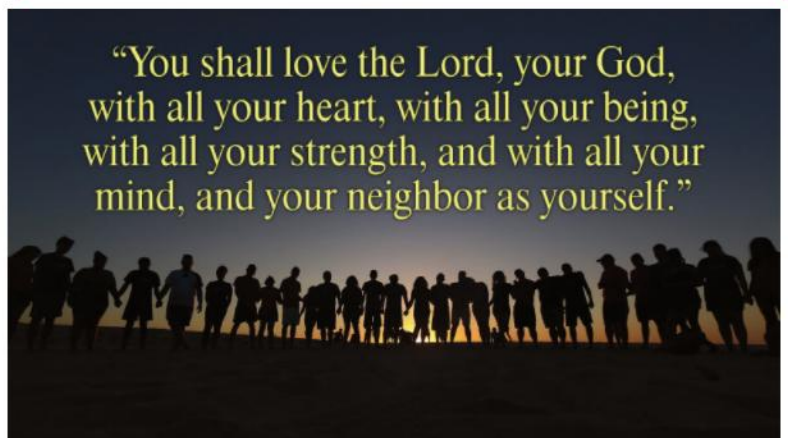
### August 2-5—Sacred Heart Sisters
