

Legacy of Life Foundation

LENTEN CHARITY - On Palm Sunday (next weekend) our sister parishes will take up a special second collection that will serve as our tri-parish Lenten charity. This year's charity will be the Legacy of Life Foundation (LOLF). The Legacy of Life Foundation is a Christ centered agency that offers an inspirational and joyful pro-life message and provides the funding for two crisis pregnancy centers, located in Bristol and Philadelphia PA. Half of all abortions in Pennsylvania take place within the city of Philadelphia. Every year more than 1000 women facing an unplanned pregnancy walk through the doors of the centers sponsored by LOLF. These women are scared, confused, and believe an abortion is their only choice. LOLF speaks to the heart of the abortion issue—they educate others on comprehensive alternatives to abortion. The mission of LOLF is to Save Lives and Transform Families, and they do this by providing free pregnancy tests and ultrasounds, material support, and through our STAR (Self-Transformation and renewal) advocacy program, a program that lasts until the saved baby is three years old. The women who walk through the doors of LOLF are met with Christ like love, compassion, and support. Their client advocates act as a liaison on the women's behalf to government programs, housing services, recovery programs, and so much more. Their STAR program builds a supportive community for women where they can focus on building their self-esteem, discover their gifts and talents, create goals, and measure their accomplishments. Speaker Marie Joseph – Marie Joseph was born in New York and was raised in a nominally Catholic home. After graduating from Cornell University, Marie lived a successful, yet non-religious life. After a painful divorce, Marie's life was turned upside down. The emptiness of her life allowed her to be open to the promptings of grace and she returned to the Catholic Church. Today Marie is the director of Legacy of Life Foundation, a crisis pregnancy agency in Philadelphia. Marie's story is one of a nominal faith turned into a rediscovery of the breadth and depth of our Catholic faith.

Speaker Dr. Gregory Sweeny – Dr. Sweeny, a native of Latrobe, is a graduate of Georgetown University Medical School and currently practices family medicine in Hollidaysburg. Dr. Sweeny and his wife are the parents of eight children, the youngest being Regina. In 2011, at the age of eleven, otherwise perfectly healthy Regina suffered a sudden and rapid decline that culminated in her death a few weeks after the onset of her sickness. Yet, in spite of their grief, Dr. Sweeny and his wife didn't lose their faith. Dr. Sweeny will speak to us about finding and hope and faith even in the most painful circumstances.


