NEW SOUND SYSTEM - Thanks to a benefactor who, on behalf of the Knights of Columbus, underwrote the cost of a new sound system for St. John's Church. The system was installed this week and is working very well. Many thanks for your generosity.

HOUSE BLESSING - In keeping with the venerable Eastern European custom, Father Aron is happy to come and bless homes around the Feast of the Epiphany. Last year 54 households had their homes blessed (that leaves 204 parish households that didn't!). Even if you had your home blessed last year, Father Aron is still happy to come and bless it this year. Don't worry about cleaning your house, remember this is particular way of asking for Divine assistance, and is not about *Better Homes and Gardens*. If you wish to have your home blessed please phone the rectory to schedule a time.

FLOWER PROJECT - Beginning this upcoming year the parish will begin a new project that will help to beautify our churches and at the same honor our deceased loved ones. Near the entrance at both churches there is a "Flower Chart" with Sunday dates listed from throughout the year (with the exception of Sundays that fall during penitential seasons and certain feasts). If you sign up for a particular date flowers will be delivered to the church where you signed the sheet for the specified weekend Masses and placed near the altar in honor of your designated loved ones. Once the weekend Mass/Masses are celebrated they can be removed and taken home (or left at the altar). The name of the loved one(s) will be listed in the bulletin. If you wish to sign up for flowers at the Sacred Heart site you will need to sign the sheet found at the entrance of the church (please note that flowers at Sacred Heart will be near the altar for both the 4:00 PM and the 8:00 AM Masses and can be taken home after the 8:00 AM Mass). If you wish to sign up for flowers for the St. John site you will need to sign the sheet at the entrance of St. John's (please note that flowers at St. John's will be near the altar for during the 10:30 AM Mass and can be taken home after right after Mass). The cost of the flowers is \$30 for two arrangements and need to be paid for two weeks in advance. If you have any questions please contact the parish office.

SLOVAK CLASSES - The parish will be sponsoring a seven week class on Slovak culture and language every Tuesday night beginning January 17. The classes are free and open to anyone who is interested in all things Slovak (and is serious about sticking with the class until finished).
